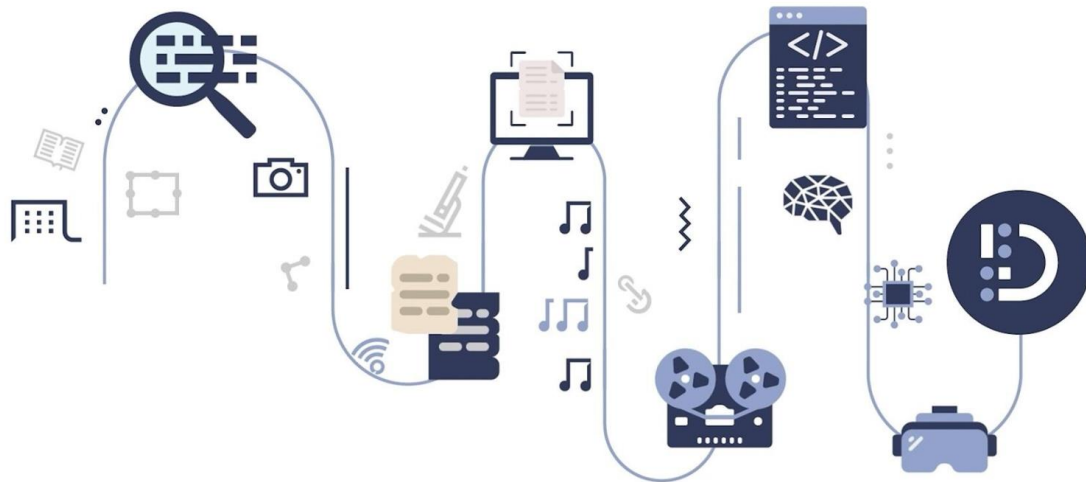

- **Problem:** some of the most meaningful **data can't be scraped, automatically generated, simulated processed**, human intervention is needed
- **We help** researchers and other user groups representing e.g. culture, health, and the arts by **creating & exploring such data**

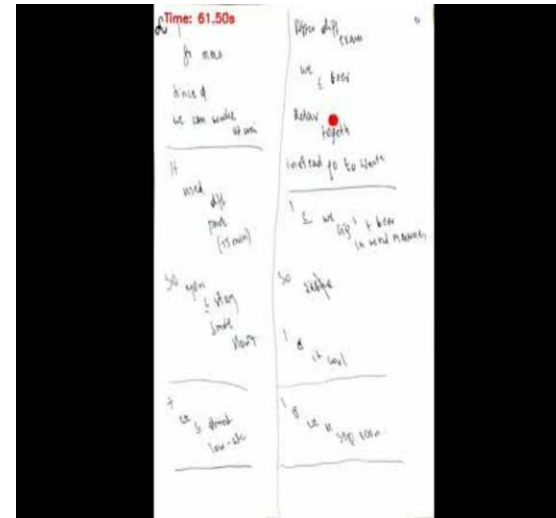


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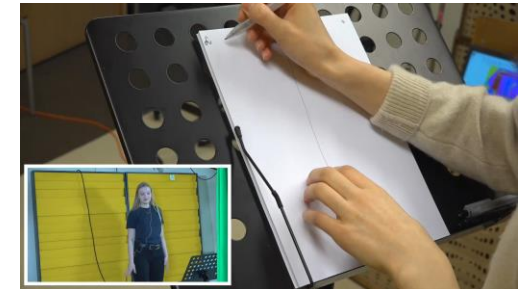


Handwritten Notes Of Interpreters

- Interpreters develop a notation system that supports **working memory, recall** and **conceptual thinking**
- Interpreter listens to the speech and takes notes, then recreates the speech from memory using notes
- A trained interpreter can memorize and translate up to 20 minute of text



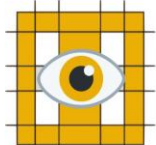
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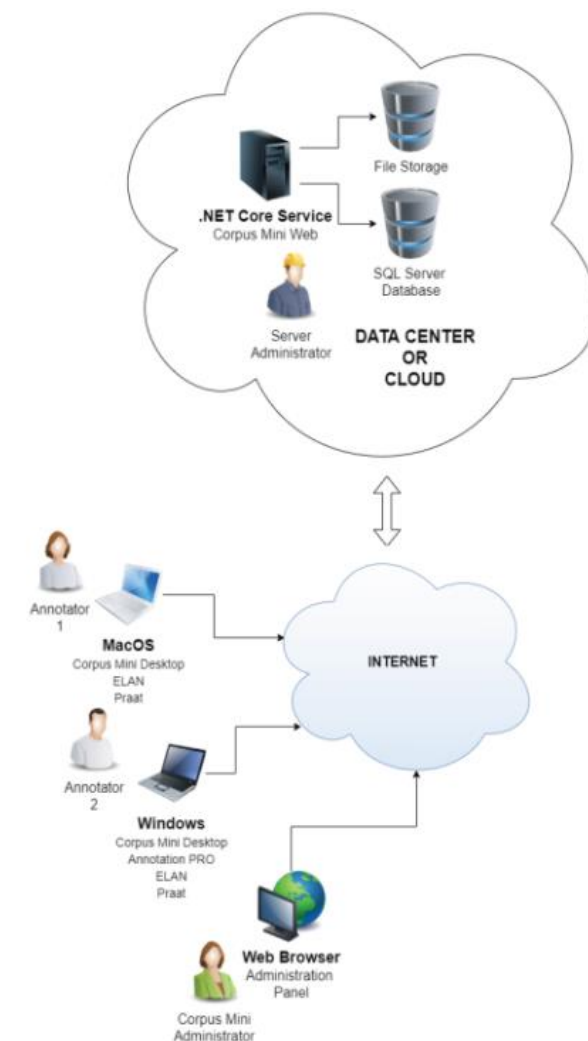
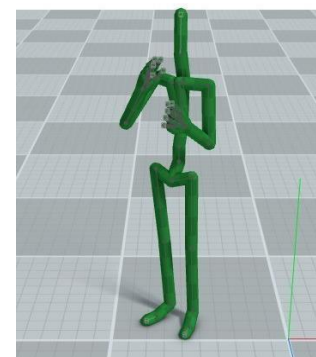
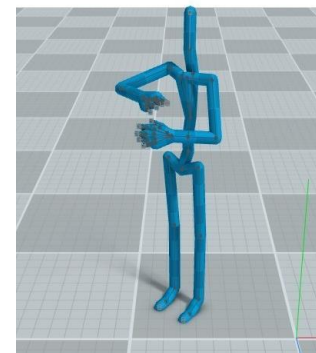
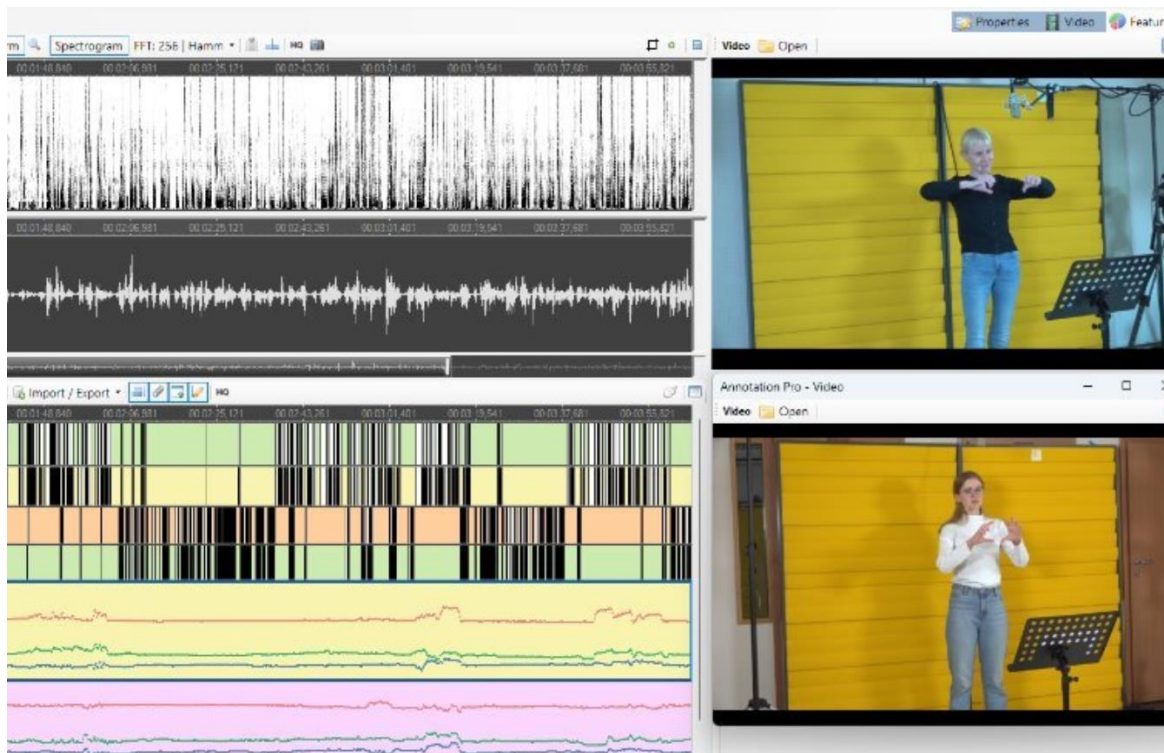

- Gesture space & speed analyzers using Motion Capture data

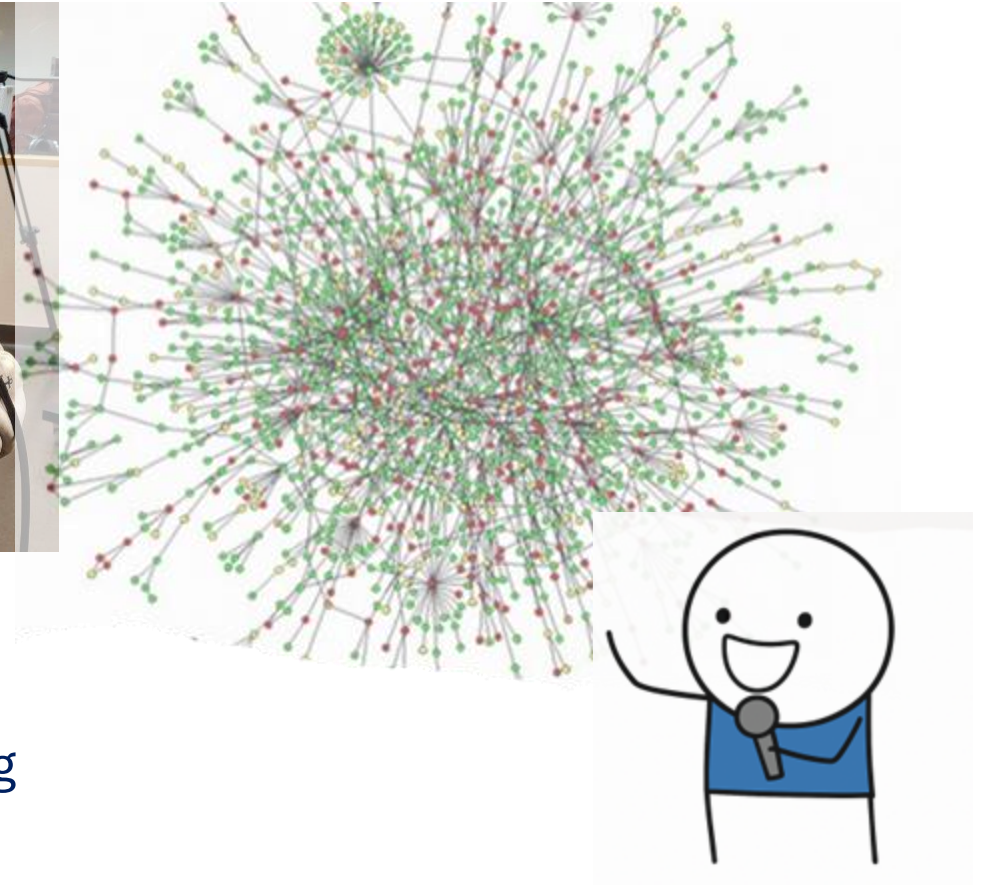
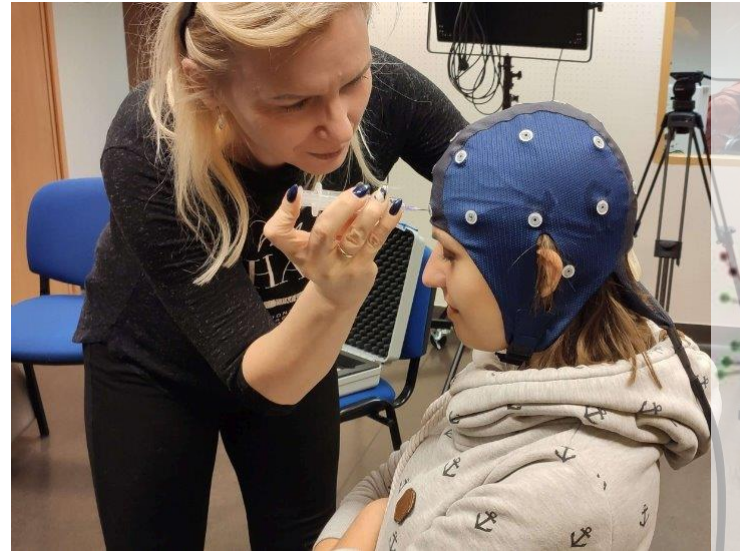


In search of melody predictors

- Digitisation laboratories: for analogue recordings, photographs and graphics



Philological hub



A cloud-based platform with a set of tools for research in literature, language, and more.

- *Researcher's Desk*, which integrates philological digital tools for **digital source editing, preparing digital editions** (e.g., *Kaliszanin*)
- A **literary mapping system** based on selected cultural texts (e.g., texts centered around the myth of Theseus, module: e-Myth)
- An **online tool for collaborative animation and hypertext creation**: [INKAH](#)
- The **Phraseological Corpus Digitalization System** (SDKf)
